MDL Crossfire Commander V7

WINDOWS Downloading and Installation Instructions

- The MDL Crossfire Commander client application is needed to access this database.
 - It is not available off campus except through EZ-Remote.
 - Beilstein Crossfire 2000 will not be supported as of 2005.
1. **Download the installer: MDLCrossFireCommander70.exe**
(<http://minerva.library.wisc.edu/commander/MDLCrossFireCommander70.exe>)
 2. **Save it on your desktop**
 3. **Install Crossfire Commander**
 - Double-click on the desktop icon for **MDLCrossFireCommander70.exe**
 - If you have previous versions of Commander installed, the installer will remove them before continuing. After the un-install of previous versions is complete, the installer will continue.
 - You can choose file locations, etc., or accept the defaults.
 - When the program asks you for an address, enter: **beilstein.library.wisc.edu**.
 - When the program asks you for a group name, enter: **cornell** in each box.
 - The installer has all the information it needs. You may finish the installation.
 4. **Run Crossfire Commander**
 - Go to the **Start** menu and choose **Programs**.
 - Unless you changed it during installation, you can run the Beilstein Commander by choosing the **MDL Crossfire Commander 7.0** folder, and looking for: **MDL Crossfire Commander 7.0**.
 - To initiate the session click on the red cross arrows icon.
 - You will then be prompted for UserID and Password, enter UserID: **cornell**, and Password **x4fsas**. Feel free to check the **Save user id and password** box if you don't want to remember the password next time. Don't try to change the password; it won't work.

Note: the default installation of Commander uses MDL IsisDraw as the default structure editor. You can change this to the MDL Crossfire Structure Editor under the OPTIONS/Structure Editor menu.

Mac Downloading and Installation Instructions

- The MDL Crossfire Commander client application is needed to access this database.
 - It is not available off campus except through EZ-Remote.
 - Beilstein Crossfire 2000 will not be supported as of 2005.
 - MDL no longer develops the Beilstein Commander for the Macintosh platform. To date, Commander 6 for Macintosh is still being supported by MDL.
 - **OSX users:** You may choose to start your Mac under Mac OS 9 for the installation. After the installation, Commander will run in the Mac OS 9 Classic environment. Newer Macintoshes can no longer startup with Mac OS 9, but the installation can run in the Classic environment from within Mac OS X.
1. Download the installer: **CrossfireV6_Installer.hqx**
(http://minerva.library.wisc.edu/commander/bc2000/CrossFireV6_Installer.hqx)
 2. Launch the installer.
 3. If previous versions of Commander were installed and you are attempting to install it in the same location, you will be warned that the contents of the old folder will be erased.
 4. Launch the Commander program, then initiate a session by clicking on the red cross arrows icon.
 5. You will get an "MDL Crossfire Server Profiles" dialog box. Select "**New...**"
 6. You will now get an "MDL Crossfire Server Profile" dialog box. All Settings should be left at the default except for host address: **beilstein.library.wisc.edu** (Note: It is no longer necessary to modify the login script.)
 7. Click on the Communication Tab and check to be sure the Port is set to **XFIRE** and the Port Number is **8001**.
 8. After making the change above hit **OK**. You will be asked to give your profile a name. Type the name in the "Create MDL CrossFire Profile" field and hit **Save**.
 9. You will get the "MDL Crossfire Server Profiles" dialog box again. **Select** the profile you just created.
 10. Next you will be asked for your Group Name and Client Name. Enter "**cornell**" in both places and hit **OK**.
 11. The last item to complete is putting in the User ID and Password. When prompted, enter the User ID and Password - all in lower case:
 - User ID: **cornell**
 - Password: **x4fsas**Click **OK** to continue on. (Note: If you don't want to be prompted for the user ID and password each time you use Commander, you can check the **Save user id and password** box. Don't try to change the password; it won't work.)

Note: the default installation of Commander uses MDL IsisDraw as the default structure editor. You can change this to the MDL Crossfire Structure Editor under the OPTIONS/Structure Editor menu.
